

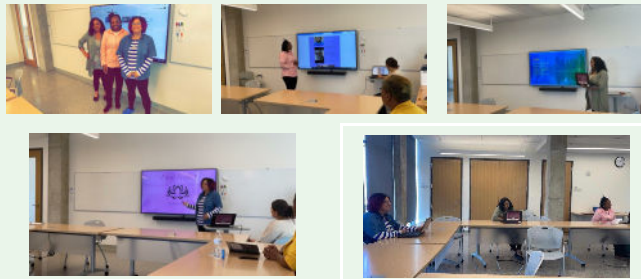

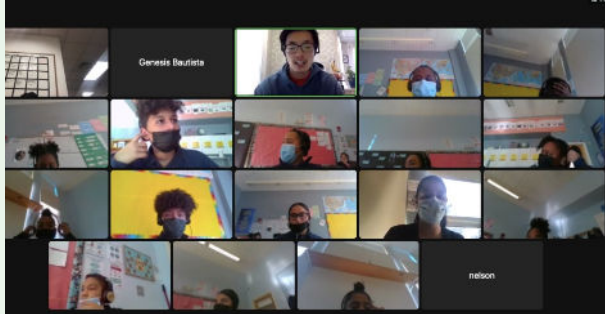
Members of the cohort presented their final projects. Their final projects were on their action plan goals, both short term and long term goals

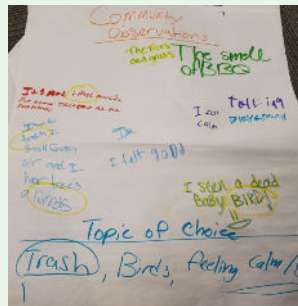

- 3/31: Networking & Career Panel (Santander)

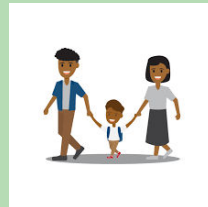


Upcoming Workshops:
